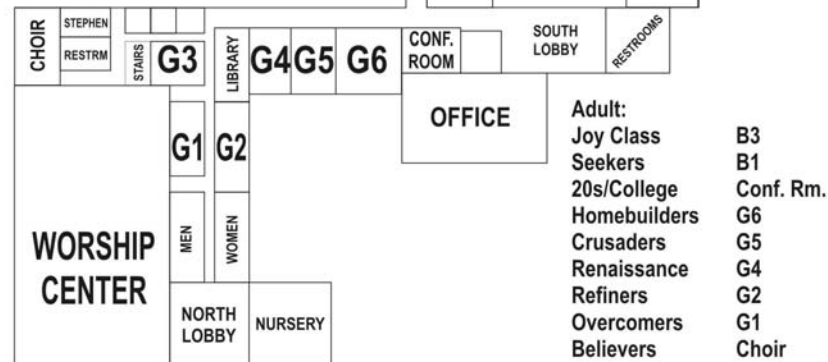
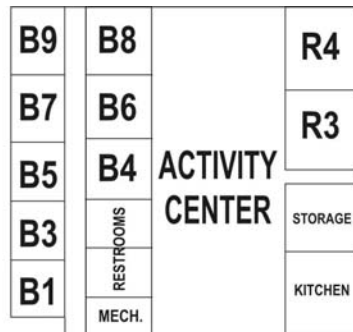

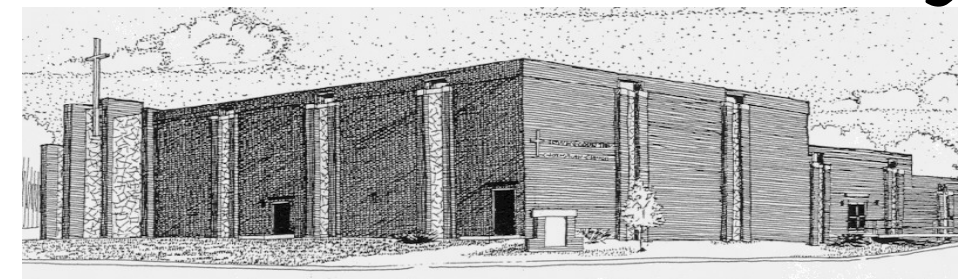
WHAT WE BELIEVE

Communion or The Lord's Supper

We have an open communion. Everyone is invited to participate. The Scriptures teach us this time is for all who believe that Jesus Christ is God's Son, and have accepted Him as their Lord and Savior. It is not just for members of Town & Country. As you partake, keep in mind we are participating as the body of Christ. This is both time for introspection and meditation as well as a time to concern yourself with your Christian brothers and sisters who are participating in this time with you. When you receive the bread and juice, you may hold them, and partake together as a Scripture is read, or you may partake whenever you would like.

Offering

This is a time when we express thanks to God in a small way for all the things He has given us. We usually have the offering after the communion. The communion reminds us of the greatest gift God has given through His Son, and the offering is our way of giving a little back to Him. You are not required to give. How much and how frequently

you donate is up to you. We ask only that you prayerfully consider what you want to place into the offering plate.

Luke 3:8

Luke 3:8 Produce fruit in keeping with repentance. And do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' For I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham. ⁹The ax is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire." ¹⁰"What should we do then?" the crowd asked. ¹¹John answered, "The man with two tunics should share with him who has none, and the one who has food should do the same." ¹²Tax collectors also came to be baptized. "Teacher," they asked, "what should we do?" ¹³"Don't collect any more than you are required to," he told them. ¹⁴Then some soldiers asked him, "And what should we do?" He replied, "Don't extort money and don't accuse people falsely—be content with your pay." ¹⁵The people were waiting expectantly and were all wondering in their hearts if John might possibly be the Christ. ¹⁶John answered them all, "I baptize you with water. But one more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. ¹⁷His winnowing fork is in his hand to clear his threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his barn, but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire." ¹⁸And with many other words John exhorted the people and preached the good news to them.
