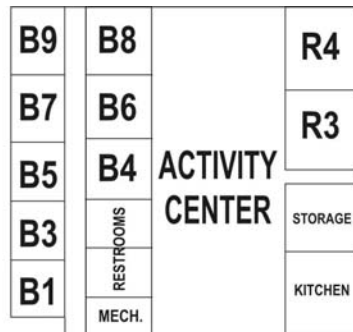

Town and Country Christian Church exists to glorify God.

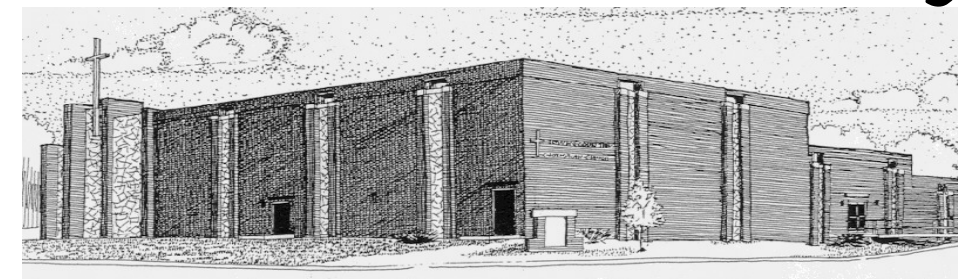
We accomplish this in three ways:

**Communion or The Lord's Supper**

We have an open communion. Everyone is invited to participate. The Scriptures teach us this time is for all who believe that Jesus Christ is God's Son, and have accepted Him as their Lord and Savior. It is not just for members of Town & Country. As you partake, keep in mind we are participating as the body of Christ. This is both time for introspection and meditation as well as a time to concern yourself with your Christian brothers and sisters who are participating in this time with you. When you receive the bread and juice, you may hold them, and partake together as a Scripture is read, or you may partake whenever you would like.

**Offering**

This is a time when we express thanks to God in a small way for all the things He has given us. We usually have the offering after the communion. The communion reminds us of the greatest gift God has given through His Son, and the offering is our way of giving a little back to Him. You are not required to give. How much and how frequently

you donate is up to you. We ask only that you prayerfully consider what you want to

**The Centurion's Faith**  
Matthew 8:5-13

Mark 6:1 Jesus left there and went to his hometown, accompanied by his disciples. <sup>2</sup>When the Sabbath came, he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were amazed. "Where did this man get these things?" they asked. "What's this wisdom that has been given him, that he even does miracles! <sup>3</sup>Isn't this the carpenter? Isn't this Mary's son and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas and Simon? Aren't his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him. <sup>4</sup>Jesus said to them, "Only in his hometown, among his relatives and in his own house is a prophet without honor." <sup>5</sup>He could not do any miracles there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. <sup>6</sup>And he was amazed at their lack of faith.

Matthew 8:5 When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to him, asking for help. <sup>6</sup>"Lord," he said, "my servant lies at home paralyzed and in terrible suffering." <sup>7</sup>Jesus said to him, "I will go and heal him." <sup>8</sup>The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed. <sup>9</sup>For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." <sup>10</sup>When Jesus heard this, he was astonished and said to those following him, "I tell you the truth, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith. <sup>11</sup>I say to you that many will come from the east and the west, and will take their places at the feast with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. <sup>12</sup>But the subjects of the kingdom will be thrown outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." <sup>13</sup>Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go! It will be done just as you believed it would." And his servant was healed at that very hour.
