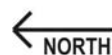
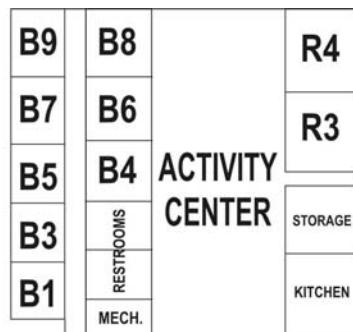

Town and Country Christian Church exists to glorify God.

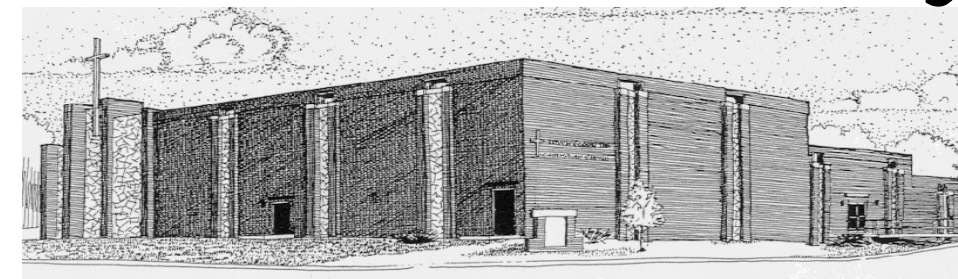
We accomplish this in three ways:

If you don't know the person beside you, they probably don't know you either. We will all be given the opportunity to greet one another during the worship time. Say "Hello" and get to know the people with whom you are worshiping

**Communion or The Lord's Supper**

We have an open communion. Everyone is invited to participate. The Scriptures teach us this time is for all who believe that Jesus Christ is God's Son, and have accepted Him as their Lord and Savior. It is not just for members of Town & Country. As you partake, keep in mind we are participating as the body of Christ. This is both time for introspection and meditation as well as a time to concern yourself with your Christian brothers and sisters who are participating in this time with you. When you receive the bread and juice, you may hold them, and partake together as a Scripture is read, or you may partake whenever you would like.

**Offering**

This is a time when we express thanks to God in a small way for all the things He has given us. We usually have the offering after the communion. The communion reminds us of the greatest gift God has given through His Son, and the offering is our way of giving a little back to Him. You are not required to give. How much and how frequently

you donate is up to you. We ask only that you prayerfully consider what you want to place into the offering plate.

### Jesus Heals a Wild Man

Luke 8:26-39

Luke 8:26 They sailed to the region of the Gerasenes, which is across the lake from Galilee. <sup>27</sup>When Jesus stepped ashore, he was met by a demon-possessed man from the town. For a long time this man had not worn clothes or lived in a house, but had lived in the tombs. <sup>28</sup>When he saw Jesus, he cried out and fell at his feet, shouting at the top of his voice, "What do you want with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg you, don't torture me!" <sup>29</sup>For Jesus had commanded the evil spirit to come out of the man. Many times it had seized him, and though he was chained hand and foot and kept under guard, he had broken his chains and had been driven by the demon into solitary places. <sup>30</sup>Jesus asked him, "What is your name?" "Legion," he replied, because many demons had gone into him. <sup>31</sup>And they begged him repeatedly not to order them to go into the Abyss. <sup>32</sup>A large herd of pigs was feeding there on the hillside. The demons begged Jesus to let them go into them, and he gave them permission. <sup>33</sup>When the demons came out of the man, they went into the pigs, and the herd rushed down the steep bank into the lake and was drowned. <sup>34</sup>When those tending the pigs saw what had happened, they ran off and reported this in the town and countryside, <sup>35</sup>and the people went out to see what had happened. When they came to Jesus, they found the man from whom the demons had gone out, sitting at Jesus' feet, dressed and in his right mind; and they were afraid. <sup>36</sup>Those who had seen it told the people how the demon-possessed man had been cured. <sup>37</sup>Then all the people of the region of the Gerasenes asked Jesus to leave them, because they were overcome with fear. So he got into the boat and left. <sup>38</sup>The man from whom the demons had gone out begged to go with him, but Jesus sent him away, saying, <sup>39</sup>"Return home and tell how much God has done for you." So the man went away and told all over town how much Jesus had done for him.

Luke 1:50 His mercy extends to those who fear him, from generation to generation.

Matthew 15:29 Jesus left there and went along the Sea of Galilee. Then he went up on a mountainside and sat down. <sup>30</sup>Great crowds came to him, bringing the lame, the blind, the crippled, the mute and many others, and laid them at his feet; and he healed them. <sup>31</sup>The people were amazed when they saw the mute speaking, the crippled made well, the lame walking and the blind seeing. And they praised the God of Israel.


Matthew 7:13 "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. <sup>14</sup>But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.
