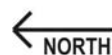
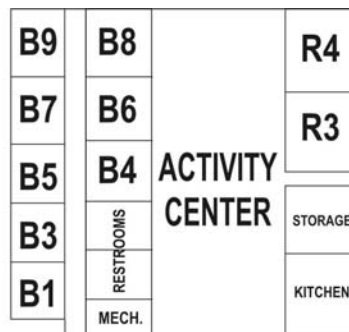

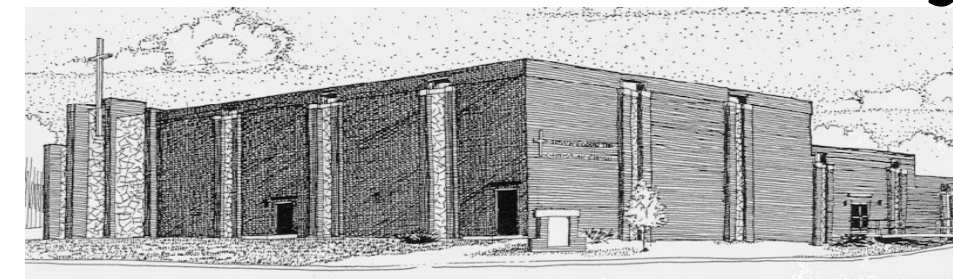
**WHAT WE BELIEVE**

**Communion or The Lord’s Supper**

We have an open communion. Everyone is invited to participate. The Scriptures teach us this time is for all who believe that Jesus Christ is God’s Son, and have accepted Him as their Lord and Savior. It is not just for members of Town & Country. As you partake, keep in mind we are participating as the body of Christ. This is both time for introspection and meditation as well as a time to concern yourself with your Christian brothers and sisters who are participating in this time with you. When you receive the bread and juice, you may hold them, and partake together as a Scripture is read, or you may partake whenever you would like.

**Offering**

This is a time when we express thanks to God in a small way for all the things He has given us. We usually have the offering after the communion. The communion reminds us of the greatest gift God has given through His Son, and the offering is our way of giving a little back to Him. You are not required to give. How much and how frequently

you donate is up to you. We ask only that you prayerfully consider what you want to place into the offering plate.
